

Validation Guide for Organization(OV) SSL Certificate

I OV

OV Certificates are required to validate your company's existence and confirm the applicant's identity. TuringSign will verify your organization's official registration directly with the relevant incorporation or registration agency.

I 5 Steps for OV SSL Validation

- 1 Domain Validation**
You have to prove that you have control over the domain for which the certificate is issued.

Methods

- Constructed Emails
- DNS TXT Record
- HTTP TXT File

- 2 Legal Existence**
Your entity name must be registered in your country, and its status must be listed as active in a government database.

Methods

- Qualified Government Information Source (QGIS)
- Qualified Independent Information Source (QIIS)
- Official Registration Documents

- 3 Physical Existence**
To verify your company's physical address, TuringSign will need to confirm the publicly listed address where your company conducts business operations.

- 4 Phone Verification**
TuringSign will make phone calls to your company's main phone number as listed in a reliable source.

Methods

- Third-Party Directory
- Dun & Bradstreet
- Yellow Page

- 5 Validation of Authority**
TuringSign will need to verify the identity of the person requesting the certificate. The Validation Agent should ask for the person's name and confirm their role in the company.
